### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Term 1 is almost complete with just over one week to go before the school holidays. However there are still many things happening with a huge week of activities planned.

On Monday we will be holding our school Cross Country at the school. Children will walk the course at 10am and then each of the senior age divisions will start from approximately 10.30am. Age divisions for this group are: 8/9 years boys & girls, 10 year boys & girls, 11 year boys & girls and 12/13 years boys & girls. The teachers and parents will join with the 12/13 year race – a big challenge ahead of us. All divisions are based on the age the student turns this year. I will be in the 31 year age-group.

The Kindergarten/Year 1 classes will be running at approximately 11.15am. Their age groups are: 5 years boys & girls, 6 years boys & girls and 7 years boys & girls.

Please note that in the event of wet weather we may need to start earlier. Children are advised to bring something water proof to sit on and perhaps a change of clothes if it is looking particularly wet.

On Thursday we will be holding a 'Level O' disco. Students who have not received a level this term will be able to attend a disco held in the school hall in the morning. Class teachers will have other special in-class activities on the day. Only students who are eligible to participate will be able to wear 'mufti' clothes.

Friday, the last day of term, we will be conducting an art exhibition commencing at 11:15 where parents can view children's art work in classes and then come up to the new hall at 11:30 for the official opening of our art exhibition.

Also on Friday we will be having our Easter Hat Parade in the amphitheatre at 12 noon. At the conclusion of the Easter Hat Parade we will draw the P and C raffle. Tickets will be on sale during recess and lunch times starting tomorrow. Tickets will be 50 cents each. We will also be selling tickets during the morning of the Easter Hat Parade.
