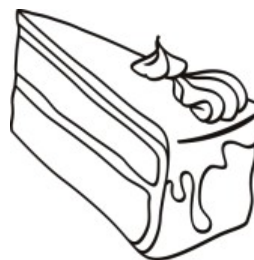
UNIFORM SHOP
