MEDICATION REGISTER

Please let the office or Mrs Laurel Astle know if there has been any change to your child's long term medication whether taken at school or at home.

HEADLICE

As infestations are particularly common in primary schools, it is best to choose a treatment that can be used over time. There is no single solution to eradication, only persistence. Two options, conditioner - buy a cheap brand as you will be needing a lot of it, and preferably one that is white to make spotting the lice easier or the chemical treatment containing synthetic or natural insecticides that kill head lice (talk to your local pharmacist to identify the treatments containing insecticides). Used with a fine toothed metal lice comb (available from your local chemist or online) and white paper towel.

- regularly check your children's hair
- teach older children to check their own hair
- tie back and braid long hair
- keep a fine tooth head lice comb in the bathroom and encourage all family members to use it when they wash their hair.
