PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Parents and Carers,

Sawtell PS staff are to be commended for their professionalism towards ensuring all students who attended school remained safe throughout unprecedented and consecutive days of poor air quality. Whilst we remained safe our thoughts are with those who have suffered loss of life and property. We also thank those who worked tirelessly to ensure the safety of our local communities. Last week there were a number of cancellations due to these unforeseen The school has finalised the Canberra conditions. excursion refunds, the 4/5 Brown assembly was postponed to this coming Friday, and parents of Year 1 and 2 students who attended the 'Learn to Swim' program will have an option of a refund for the 2 days missed or purchase mini fair tokens with their refund. Further details were sent home earlier this week for parents of Year 1 and 2 students.

Staffing Sawtell PS for 2020 is close to completion. Specific classes individual teachers will be teaching is still uncertain as enrolments tend to fluctuate at the commencement of the school year, and this can impact on class structures. The school congratulates Miss Thomson on gaining a 12 month full time temporary contract in Grafton next year. We will also be bidding farewell to Miss Faircloth. Miss Faircloth and Miss Thomson have been a part of our school community over the past 12 months and 2 years respectively.
