PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Dear Parents and Carers,

Stage 3 students would like to thank the wonderful support they received from the school community last Thursday for the Mini Fair. The Mini Fair was a huge success as part of building leadership capabilities for senior students. The feedback from parents and students was overwhelmingly positive.

As many of you would be aware Sawtell PS has a considerable number of temporary teachers holding positions or part of positions belonging mostly to permanent staff members. Due to the 2019 staffing composition not all of these positions remain as they currently stand. As a result, the school made the decision to advertise all temporary positions through the 'expression of interest' process state-wide to ensure transparency. The panel consisting of staff and parent representatives as well as myself have been overwhelmed by the number of applicants. The process is still underway and a determination will be made towards the end of next week.

Major excursion fever has struck! Today Year 4 departed for Cascade for a 2 night excursion. Cascade is an environmental field studies centre run by the Department of Education. Next week Year 6 depart for a week long excursion to Sydney where they will enjoy the sights of Sydney as well as some very exciting museums. In Week 8, Year 3 students embark on an overnight excursion to Yarrahapinni. Yarrahapinni provides an opportunity for students to take part in both environmental and personal development activities.

The school has endeavoured to move these major excursions away from the end of the year to reduce financial burdens on families and to evenly spread additional curriculum loads across the school year.
